To extend the suspension of duty on Desmondur HL BA.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESMODUR HL BA.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.18 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 Benzene, 1,3-diisocyanatomethyl-, polymer with 1,6-
7 diisocyanatohexane dissolved in n-butyl acetate) is amend-
8 ed by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
