CHAIRMAN BROADBENT: Good morning. This meeting of the U.S. International Trade Commission will now come to order.

Welcome to Commissioners Williamson and Johanson who are participating by telephone.

COMMISSIONER WILLIAMSON: Okay.

CHAIRMAN BROADBENT: Hello. Hi, there.

COMMISSIONER WILLIAMSON: Good morning.

CHAIRMAN BROADBENT: I understand that there are no agendas for future meetings, minutes, ratification lists or outstanding action jackets to consider.

Next, we turn to the vote on Investigation Numbers 701-499 through 500 and 731-1215 through 1217 and 1219 through 1223, Certain Oil Country Tubular Goods from India, Korea, Philippines, Taiwan, Thailand, Turkey, Ukraine, and Vietnam.

1 Welcome to Ms. DeFilippo and the staff who
2 participated in these investigations which were both
3 extremely challenging, I think, particularly recently. So
4 thank you all for all the work that you guys did.

5 Are there any questions for the staff?

7 CHAIRMAN BROADBENT: Are there any additions or
8 corrections to the staff report?

9 MS. DeFILIPPO: Catherine DeFilippo, Office of

12 out to be an incredibly difficult case from start to finish.
13 They did a fantastic job and I want to thank them for that.

14 With regard to revisions, staff proposes that the
15 staff report for the subject investigations be revised in
16 accordance with Memoranda INV MM075 and 081, dated August
17 6th and August 20th, 2014. Staff has no further revisions.

18 CHAIRMAN BROADBENT: Is there any objection to
19 approval of the staff report as revised?

20 (No response.)

21 CHAIRMAN BROADBENT: Hearing none, it is
22 approved.

23 Mr. Secretary, will you please call the roll?

24 MR. BISHOP: Commissioner Johanson?

25 COMMISSIONER JOHANSON: I vote in the affirmative

1 with respect to India, Korea, Taiwan, Turkey, Ukraine, and
2 Vietnam. I vote in the negative with respect to the
3 Philippines and Thailand.

4 MR. BISHOP: Commissioner Broadbent?

5 COMMISSIONER BROADBENT: I vote in the
6 affirmative with respect to India, Korea, Turkey, Ukraine,
7 and Vietnam. I vote in the negative with respect to the
8 Philippines, Taiwan and Thailand.

9 MR. BISHOP: Commissioner Kieff is not
10 participating. Commissioner Schmidtlein?

11 COMMISSIONER SCHMIDTLEIN: I vote in the
12 affirmative with respect to India, Korea, Taiwan, Turkey,
13 Ukraine and Vietnam. I vote in the negative with respect to
14 the Philippines and Thailand.

15 MR. BISHOP: Commissioner Williamson?

16 COMMISSIONER WILLIAMSON: I vote in the negative
17 with respect to the Philippines and Thailand. And I vote in
18 the affirmative with respect to all the other countries.

19 MR. BISHOP: Commissioner Pinkert?

20 COMMISSIONER PINKERT: I vote in the negative
21 with respect to the Philippines and Thailand. I vote in the
22 affirmative with respect to India, Korea, Taiwan, Turkey,
23 Ukraine, and Vietnam.

24 MR. BISHOP: Madame Chairman, the Commission has
25 reached affirmative determinations with respect to India,

1 Korea, Taiwan, Turkey, Ukraine and Vietnam. The Commission
2 has reached a negative determination with respect to the
3 Philippines and Thailand.

4 CHAIRMAN BROADBENT: Thank you, Mr. Secretary.
5 Further information regarding these determinations will be
6 in the press release. The Commission is currently
7 scheduled to file its determinations on September 2nd, 2014.

8 Thank you to all staff who participated in these
9 investigations. Seeing that there is no other business
10 before the Commission this meeting is adjourned.
