CHAIRMAN JOHANSON: Good morning. I hereby open
the hearing for Silicon Metal from Russia, Investigation No.
731-TA-991, Third Review.

Mr. Secretary, are there any preliminary matters?

MR. BISHOP: Mr. Chairman, I would note for the
record that all participants on today's teleconference have
been noted for the record.

CHAIRMAN JOHANSON: Thank you, Mr. Secretary.

The purpose of this review is to determine
whether revocation of the antidumping duty order on Silicon
Metal from Russia would be likely to lead to continuation or
recurrence of material injury within any reasonable
foreseeable time.

In accordance with 19 USC Section 1677, TA-1, the
Commission has not cancelled this hearing. But in light of
the restrictions on access to the Commission building, the
Commission will conduct this hearing through a series of
written questions, admissions of written testimony, written
responses to questions and posthearing briefs, and oral
arguments.

The schedule for this hearing in this proceeding

3 5:15 p.m., parties submit and serve witness testimony.

4 Witness testimony is limited to 40 pages. Accompanying
5 visual materials, for example photographs and presentation
6 slides, do not count against the page limit.

7 Tuesday, March 31st, 2020, which is today, at
8 9:30 a.m, Commission teleconference hearing to announce a
9 new date.

10 Tuesday, March 31st, 2020, at 12:00 noon,
11 Commission staff will send a first set of questions to
12 parties.

13 Thursday, April 2nd, 2020, by 5:15 p.m., parties
14 submit and serve responses to the first set of questions.
15 Responses to the third set of questions is limited to six
16 pages, with BPI versions on April 2nd, 2020 and public
17 versions the following day.

18 Monday, April 6, 2020, by 5:15 p.m. Commission
19 staff will send a second set of questions to parties.

20 Wednesday, April 8th, 2020, by 5:15 p.m., parties
