

EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in

Cut-to-Length Carbon Steel Plate from China, Russia, and Ukraine Inv. Nos. 731-TA-753, 754, and 756 (Fourth Review)

On February 5, 2021, the Commission determined to conduct expedited reviews in the subject five-year reviews pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a response to its notice of institution filed jointly by three domestic producers of cut-to-length carbon steel plate (“CTL plate”): ArcelorMittal USA LLC, Nucor Corporation, and SSAB Enterprises, LLC. The Commission found each domestic producer’s individual response to be adequate. The Commission received data from producers accounting for a substantial share of domestic production of CTL plate and therefore determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested parties, and accordingly determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate with respect to the reviews of CTL plate from all three subject countries.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that warranted conducting full reviews. The Commission, therefore, decided to conduct expedited reviews with respect to CTL plate from all three subject countries.
