

## EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATIONS ON ADEQUACY

in

*Steel Wire Garment Hangers from Taiwan and Vietnam*  
Inv. Nos. 701-TA-487 and 731-TA-1197-1198 (Review)

On February 5, 2018, the Commission unanimously determined to conduct expedited reviews in the subject five-year reviews pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a response to the notice of institution from M&B Metal Products Company, Inc., a domestic producer of steel wire garment hangers. The Commission found the domestic interested party's response to be individually adequate. Because the responding domestic producer accounted for a substantial portion of domestic steel wire garment hangers production in 2016, the Commission determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive any response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group responses were inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews and determined to conduct expedited reviews of the orders.
